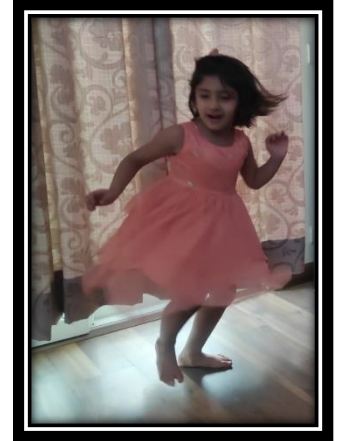

This activity helped students to build their confidence, enhance their vocabulary and learn proper telephone etiquettes. It was a fun learning experience for the students.

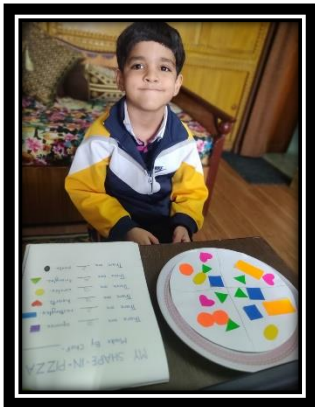
### GRADE-K1 ROLE PLAY TELEPHONE TALK

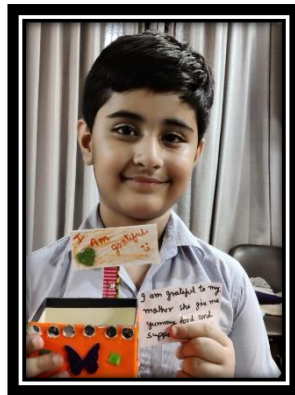
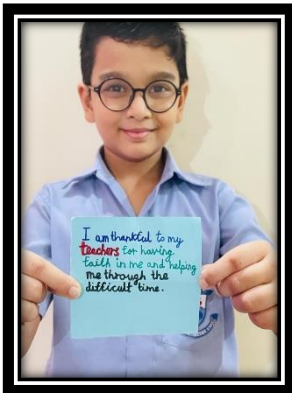
## Activity and Events

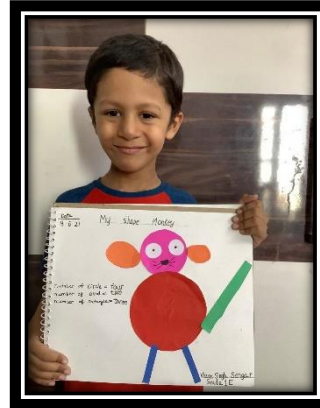
