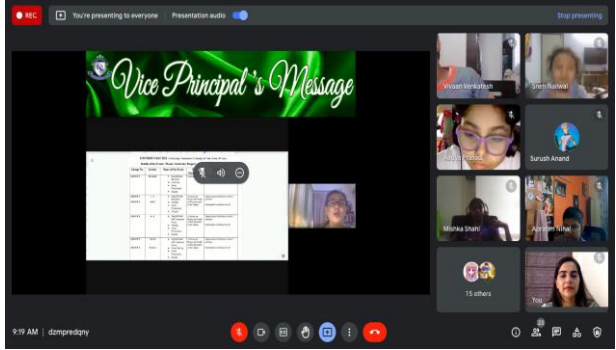
resources to its development. Founder's Day is celebrated on 23rd July every year by all the Kotharians. This is a day we pay homage to our Founder Father.


Despite the fact that it was held online, it was a moving tribute to our Founder family, with an enthusiastic turnout from students and teachers.

As we are aware patterns help us organize our thoughts and


