Dear Parent

We take this opportunity to welcome you to **Kothari International School Fraternity**. We wish you and your ward joyous and fruitful years ahead. The School and the Parent together are responsible in shaping the future of a child, hence your cooperation is of utmost importance. Most of these details are available in the Student's Almanac which will be made available when the child joins the School.

Kindly note the following points carefully:

A. The session commences for the K2 Students from Thursday, 6th April 2023.

- On **6th April 2023** parents are requested to drop their wards to School at **9:00 am** and hand them over to their Grade Tutors. In the afternoon the students availing the Transport facility will be boarded on their designated buses at **1:00 pm**. Kindly pick up your ward from the respective Bus Stop.
- From **10th April 2023**, Bus User students may avail the Transport facility both ways.
- The **Walker students** may be picked up from the **K2 Octagon** at the same time.

B. Safety and precautions:

- Safety regulations require that the person picking up your ward from the School carries the '**Parent Authorisation Card**' at all times. It will be given to the parents by the Grade Tutors after verifying all required details with them.
- Always keep the School informed if your home staff particularly 'maids' or 'drivers' have discontinued their services with you. Please ensure that you take back the 'Authorisation Card' issued by the School from your helpers.

C. Identity Card:

- The students must wear their **Old Identity Card** to the School every day till they receive the New ID Card. New students should wear Name Tags till they receive their ID Cards from the School.

D. Transport:

- The School will do its best to ensure the safety of the children. A nanny and a helper will accompany the children en-route to ensure the safety of the children.
- Bus users will be allowed to get off the bus at allotted stop **only if** the escort is present with the **Authorisation Card**, else they will be brought back to the School.
- The children will board the allotted bus route and no requests for change of bus stops will be entertained except for genuine cases which have prior consent from the concerned Authorities.

E. Accessories:

- Kindly label all articles sent to the School with the students, including the shoes clearly to facilitate their return in case of misplacement.
- A set of spare clothes neatly labelled with your child's name is to be deposited with the Grade Tutor to meet any contingency.

F. Messages and Circulars:

- Messages / Instructions are sent home in the child's Almanac, so please check the Almanac each day.
- The child should carry the School Almanac in a proper labelled school bag every day.

G. Mid Morning Snacks:

- A nutritious and hygienic mid-morning snack is served to the students.
- Students must bring a labelled water bottle every day.

H. Birthday Celebrations:

- On their Birthday, the students are greeted in the Class/Morning Assembly. We request the parents **not** to send cakes and expensive gifts to be distributed to his/her child's classmates and teachers. Please send either **a small chocolate** or **two toffees** per child with your ward to be given to his/her friends.

I. Parent Teacher Interaction:

- The Parent-Teacher Interactions are an indispensable part of school – home interaction. It is mandatory to attend them on the scheduled date. Kindly adhere to the timings.
- As part of our school practice, parents are requested not to meet the teachers during the school hours. In special cases, you may meet the teacher by prior appointment.
