The Northern Indian plains lie to the south of the Himalayas. These are formed by the alluvial deposits laid down by the rivers– the Indus, the Ganga, the Brahmaputra and their tributaries. These river plains provide fertile land for cultivation. In the western part of India lies the Great Indian Desert. It is a dry, hot and sandy stretch of land. It has very little vegetation. To the south of the northern plains lies the Peninsular plateau. The Vindhyas and the Saputras are the important ranges. The rivers Narmada and Tapi flow through these ranges. These are west-flowing rivers that drain into the Arabian Sea. The Western Ghats or Sahyadris border the plateau in the west and the Eastern Ghats provide the eastern boundary.

- c. What lies in the western part of India? Name the state where it is located.
- d. Which rivers flow in the peninsular plateau? Name any two states of the Deccan Plateau.
