2	SOCIAL SCIENCE	Week 3	"A Day in the Market" – Market Observation Report Each student visits or observes any one market near their home (e.g., vegetable market, local grocery store, mall, or online shopping site). They prepare a Market Observation Report that includes: Type of market observed. 3–4 goods or services sold there. Who are the buyers and sellers? How is the price decided (fixed, bargained, or online pricing)? Any advantages or disadvantages noticed for buyers and sellers. Students conclude with a short paragraph on how markets connect producers and consumers.	The students will be able to: 1. Identify different types of markets (weekly market, neighbourhood shop, shopping complex, online market). 2. Understand how buyers and sellers interact in different types of markets.
